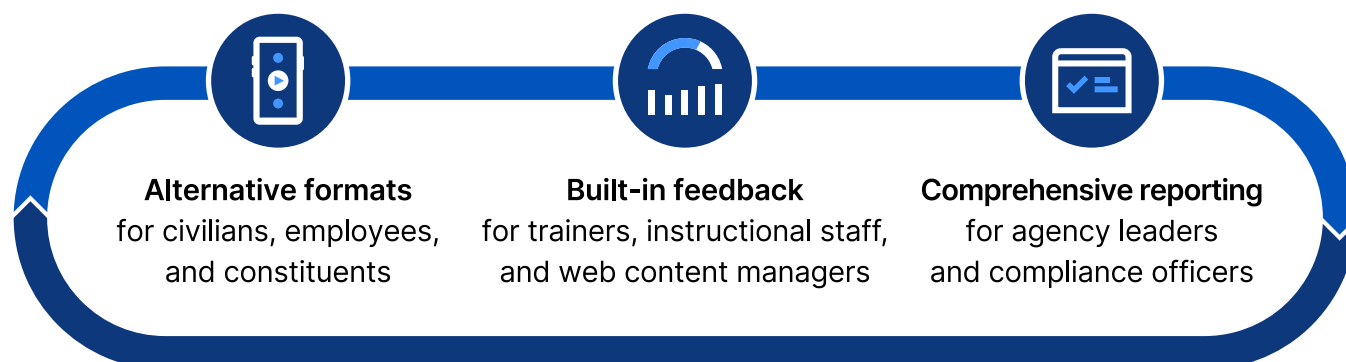

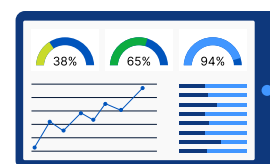
Gain actionable insight and guidance
